Booking

Provisional reservations can be made by telephone and will be held for one week or until receipt of 25% of full cost of stay as non-returnable deposit and completed booking form. Cheques are payable to **The Bolthole** and forwarded to Karen Hunter-Roberts - The Old Rectory, Fradswell, Stafford. ST18 0EY. A fully refundable fee of £300 is requested to cover any damage or breakages to the property. This will be returned to the tenant once the property has been checked and all keys returned. The balance of the holiday charge along with the security fee must be received eight weeks prior to the commencement of the booking. Late bookings must be confirmed with fees and security in full. All bookings are Saturday to Saturday.

Booking Form

The signature on the booking form agrees to the booking conditions on behalf all persons included on the booking form, ensuring vigilance of any potential risks that may cause injury and noting our strict no smoking/pet policy. The authorised signatory must be over 18 years old and be a member of the party renting the property.

Cancellation

Cancellation of a booking must be notified as soon as possible. Every endeavor to re let the property will be made; however, if no re letting is effective; all Monies paid will be forfeited. (With exception of security fee). If property is re let, all monies less the 25% deposit will be returned.

Tenancy

The Tenancy created by this agreement is a Holiday Let within paragraph 9 of Part 1 of the Housing Act 1988.

Once accommodation has been booked and confirmed, you have entered into a binding contract with the owners.

Number in party

The accommodation may only be occupied by the persons named on the booking form. The maximum number of persons allowed to stay in the Bolthole must not be greater than six (excluding children under one year) without prior permission from the owners.

Entry/Exit

Entry into the property is from 2pm on the day of booking. You are asked to vacate the property before 10am on day of departure. The accommodation must be left in a clean and tidy condition with a note of any breakages or findings requiring attention.

A deduction from the security deposit will be taken to cover any damage or breakage.

Visitors are responsible for replacing or repairing any breakages or damages. All damage must be reported to the owners.

When completing your stay, please ensure you place the keys back into the security box at the entry of the property, resetting the code to '0000', and that all electrical appliances are turned off, with the exception of the boiler on the top floor and the WI-FI hub in the lounge.

The Right to Entry

The owners reserve the right to entry at all times for the inspection of or to carry out repairs to the internal and external property.

Health & Safety

The authorised signatory agrees to read these health and safety guidelines and ensure that all members in the party understand the importance of safety. Smoke alarms are fitted to ground, first and second floors and are linked. Fire extinguisher and fire blanket can be found in the kitchen. You must only tackle a fire if you feel capable of doing so. The fire service must be called on detecting a fire. Any tampering with the fire safety equipment unless in the event of a real emergency will result in forfeit of all security monies.

The Window on first floor to the rear of the property opens very wide to enable escape in the event of a fire. <u>All persons must be made aware of the dangers</u> of falling from a window when fully open. Keep windows closed or on the tilt opening. If you decide to lock windows to help prevent accidents do not hide/lose keys as they are necessary to fully open in the event of a fire.

Please take care when descending stairs, as they are very steep. Use handrail provided. It is good practice to lock the lower stable door when not in use to prevent accidental fall down to lower level.
